Kelly Newman performed in Cabaret as a Kit Kat Girl at Salem State University.

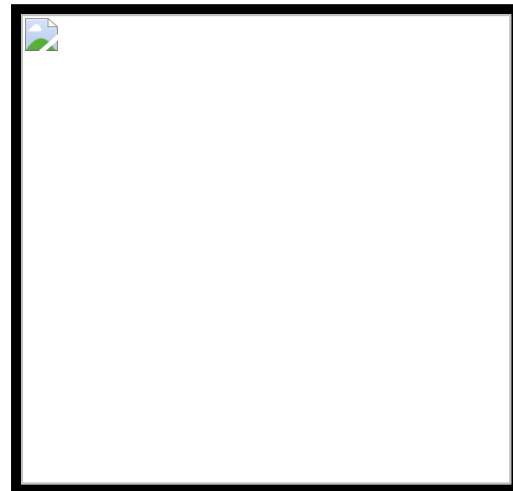
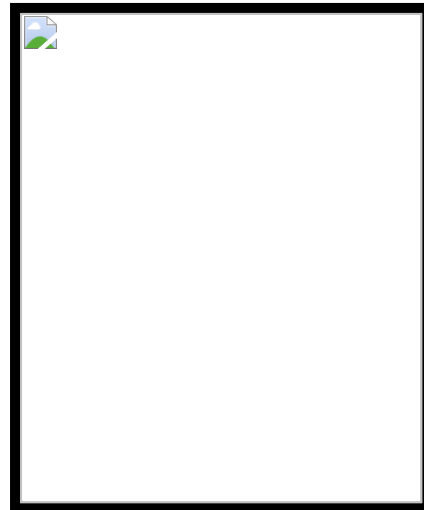

How much do you know about theater? Each newsletter issue will provide information about the technical and behind the scenes aspects of the theater arts.

For the upcoming production of *Puss in Boots*, the script calls for a mouse to run across the stage. Most likely, the tech director will use a special effect like the one that was successful in WCT's production of *Cinderella*. For that production, a paper mache pumpkin was rigged with a remote control car under it and navigated across the stage from stage right. A little practice with steering from off stage is all it takes!
