Justin received his undergraduate degree in Communication from Westfield State University and a Masters in Higher Education from Merrimack College. He is currently serving as the





#### **THEATER 101**

How much do you know about the theater arts? Each newsletter issue will provide information about the technical and behind the scenes aspects of the theater arts.

On occasion, there will be skills required of actors that they will need specialized training in, if they are not already skilled in that area. For example, plays may require dancing, language accents or dialects, or sword fighting. For WCT's production of *Pinocchio*, there is a circus scene in which the Director, *Justin Connolly*, wanted authentic circus skills performed. He called on WCT Alum and circus

performer, *Doug Stewart*, to train the actors.

Doug Stewart began his involvement with WCT in Treasure Island (2012). Since then he has continued to offer help backstage in addition to founding his own touring circus, Cirque Us! This summer, Doug took time away from his tour to teach cast members various styles of juggling such as 3-ball, partner juggling, spinning poi, and devil sticks in preparation for Pinocchio's big circus scene. He was also kind enough to lend us some of his equipment for the summer. Cirque Us! will be bringing their show DreamCycle to Massachusetts and Rhode Island the first week of August.
