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Happy New Year from WCT!



Theater 101

How much do you know about the theater arts? Each newsletter issue will provide information about the technical and behind the scenes aspects of the theater arts.

At the very back of the stage there is a large wall that the WCT crew refers to as the "cyc". This is a nickname for *Cyclorama*. According to *Encyclopedia Britannica*, in theater, the *cyclorama*, is a background device employed to cover the back and sometimes the sides of the stage and used with special lighting to create the illusion of sky, open space, or great distance at the rear of the stage setting.

Introduced early in the 20th century, a cyclorama usually forms a smoothly curving, concave wall at the rear of the stage. Although some theaters have a curved back wall that serves as a permanent cyclorama, it most commonly consists of a drop or traverse curtain that can be deployed according to need.

WCT will often paint a set scene on the back wall of the Footlighters Playhouse stage or use it for additional lighting effects. For the upcoming production of *James and the Giant Peach*, WCT crew members will be utilizing a light blue material drop as a *cyc* to cast shadow onto as a special effect.
